## COVID-19 VACCINATION



Dear Parents and Caregivers

Aspen Medical will be offering the Pfizer vaccine on **Wednesday 17 November 2021 at Birdwood High School**. The Pfizer vaccine will be available to all students **aged 12 years and over and also to parents, carers, siblings (over 12 years) and community members**.

Only the Pfizer vaccine will be offered. Second doses are available if you have had the first dose of the Pfizer vaccine at another clinic, however evidence of the first dose will need to be provided.

There is a 7 day interval required between the COVID-19 VACCINE and other vaccinations. If you have had another vaccine such as AstraZeneca and would like to have the Pfizer vaccine, this can be considered upon the medical officer's advice on the day to ensure protection.

Appointments are available between 9.30am to 3.30pm. Bookings are essential and can be made on line via the following link:

2. Medicare Card (or photo of Medicare Card)
3. If you would like to be present for your child's vaccination but not need a vaccination booking for yourself please ensure you sign in on arrival at the school
