Start of the year

As we communicated last year, Birdwood High School will continue with a staggered start this year. Our Year 7 and 12 students will return to school on Monday 30 January and 8 to 11 students will commence school on Tuesday 31 January.

On Monday our Year 7 and 12 students will participate in a program that will focus on developing positive habits for learning, conditions for success and familiarizing themselves with the school. All students are required to bring their laptops with them on Monday.

Mobile Phones

This year I am seeking support from families regarding our new mobile phone policy. Year 7 to 11 students are not permitted to access mobile phones and personal digital devices, excluding laptop computers, from the start to the end of each school day. Students who choose to bring mobile phones and personal digital devices to school must place them in a supplied pouch during morning Advisory and will collect them during advisory at the end of the day. This includes taking off any wearable technology that fits the definition of personal devices, such as smartwatches. Exemptions for students who use a device to manage a health condition or a student has personal circumstances that require them to have more ready access to their personal device, such as a primary carer to younger siblings or an unwell family member. Applications for exemptions can be made by emailing the principal directly, mark.hodgson426@schools.sa.edu.au

Students using EFTPOS facilities at the canteen will need to use a card rather than their phone or bring along money to purchase items.
